Out of the Past

November 14, 1924

District fire warden William Rigstadt issued his report of activities for the three county area in which Iron County is located during the past fire season. The crew consisted of District Warden (1), Regular Game & Fire Warden (2), Special Fire Warden (2), Tower Watchmen (2), Fire Boss (2), Keymen (15) and two fire boss companies of six men each. A total of 56 fires occurred in the district with Iron County reporting 48 fires which burned a total of 11,260 acres. The origin of the fires set were hunters, campers, fishermen (34), railroad locomotives (13), brush burning (4) and the remainder of unknown origin.

The next term of the Iron County Circuit Court will feature 60 petitioners for United States citizenship. Under the new arrangement the petitioners who will report to the court have been passed upon as to their qualifications by the federal officers so that no more examining will be done by the judge in the open court. The petitioner will appear with his witnesses and take the oath of allegiance.
