The ore-carrying trade out of Crystal Falls has greatly increased during the past few days. A total of 21 trains registered at the depot in a 24 hour period. The Columbia Mine (Tobin) is contributing much to this shipment sending forth about 1,000 tons per day. According to General Manager Frank Scadden the mine is in fine production condition with new hoisting equipment planning to be installed in the near future. The Crystal Falls Mine is mining and shipping 400 tons daily, the ore being of improved quality as a greater depth is reached, owing to the absence of sand which sifted into the ore nearer the surface.
