Irving Jackson has constructed a much higher dam where the old structure stood at the "water works pond" located at the west end of Urban Avenue. He hopes to be able to impound sufficient water to furnish him the bulk of the ice that he will harvest this winter. The pond was the source for the City of Crystal Falls water supply beginning in 1890 until the construction of the Paint River Falls Power plant in 1902.
