Diamond Drill Out of the Past

A large 30' spruce of near perfect proportions was transplanted on the terrace in front of the Iron County Courthouse by employees of the Crystal Falls City's Electrical and Street Departments. Overlooking Superior Avenue, the migrant spruce will serve as a permanent Community Christmas tree for the City and will be the focal point of the holiday décor. In recent years the City has had to go through the expense and effort of cutting a large tree each Christmas and the new tree plucked with its roots from City property near the Northeast City limits ends the burdensome and expensive annual task.
