Crystal Falls City Officials have increased the fire protection contract for Crystal Falls Township by \$500. The previous rate was \$2,000 per year or the equivalent of one-half mill which ever was greater. At one time the Township during a 12 year period was paying a flat rate per call. It cost the City \$16,000 per year to operate the fire department.

Annual motor vehicle registrations for 1959 were reported this week for Iron County. The Michigan Secretary of State Office showed that a total of 9,145 vehicles were registered which included 6,611 passenger cars. A total of \$150,032 was collected in license fees for the County.
