
Diamond Drill Out of the Past

Russell Berg has retired from the Crystal Falls Post Office after 19 years of service. Berg joined the Crystal Falls Office as a substitute in December 1955, eventually earned full time status and spent the last 6 years as clerk becoming well known as the friendly face behind the counter. Born in Commonwealth, Wisconsin in 1912, he moved to Crystal Falls with his family in 1917. After graduating from Crystal Falls High School he was employed by Inland Steel Company, Clairmont Transfer Co. and Flood Supply interrupted by military service during WWII from March 1941 through 1945.

Two Crystal Falls young men, brothers Jack and Larry Bicigo have purchased the heating and sheet metal business operated here for the last 17 years by Keith Bacon. The new owners are the sons of Mr. and Mrs. Emil Bicigo and recent graduates of Forest Park High School, Jack (1971) and Larry (1973).
