Out of the Past

June 13, 1924

The Catholic section of the Crystal Falls Cemetery located in the Northeast section of the property has been greatly improved. The area has been entirely brushed, cleared and grubbed of the tanglewood that gave it a poor appearance. In the past there has not been any plan for lot layout or sale and the City is moving forward to establish a plat and procedures to organize the property. A roadway will be built around the perimeter of the entire 20 acre cemetery and new roads will run east and west through the entire cemetery. The present north and south roads will be maintained and extended to the entire plot of ground. About 1,500 pine and spruce seedlings have also been planted. Since opening in 1887 there have been over 1,000 burials in the cemetery.
