The formal dedication ceremony of the Eddie Chambers Memorial Gym was held at the Forest Park High School. A memorial cast aluminum plague purchased with contributions from friends of the late Trojan Coach was unveiled. The presentation featured a long resume of Chambers' involvement in the Crystal Falls area sports community. Although mostly remembered as a successful basketball coach, he also coached tennis and golf at Crystal Falls High School. A graduate of the University of Michigan where he was regarded as one of the top college athletes in the nation, Chambers was a star athlete on the local independent basketball and baseball teams and a well-respected Upper Peninsula sports official in both basketball and football. He was selected as a charter member of the Upper Peninsula Sports Hall of Fame in 1972.
